- 1. Entry Forms may be submitted by:
  - a. Mail Entry Forms to: Brooklin Spring Fair Homecraft Entry PO Box 35, Cannington ON L0E1E0
  - b. On-line, Complete Entry Forms at: www.brooklinspringfair.com through assistexpo.
- 2. All Paper (Mailed) Entry Forms must be postmarked no later than Friday May 7th, 2021.
  - a. If/when mailing please do not lick the envelopes but seal them with tape/glue.
  - b. Entries for paper entry forms are to be mailed and postmarked no later than Wed. May 26 and sent to:

- c. Mailed entries MUST include the exhibitor name and category attached to each entry.
- 3. All Online Entry Forms must be received through the online enty platform by midnight Thursday May 27th.
  - a. Entries for online entry forms MUST be submitted at the same time as you submit your entry form. You can add your categories to the "cart" but do not check out until such time as you have uploaded all photos of your entries.
- 4. All entries must be submitted on the printed Entry Form provided in this prize list catalogue or through the online playform on the website. Paper Entry Forms can be photocopied if more space is required. Entry Forms must be dated and signed by the exhibitor when mailing.
- 5. All work must be that of the exhibitor. For online entires, all photos of enrities must be originals taken by the Exhibitor. A maximum of one entry photo per section will be accepted.
- 6. All exhibitors must be amateurs.

- 7. All exhibits must not have been previously shown at the Brooklin Spring Fair and will not be judged as a result.
- 8. No person shall enter more than one article per section.
- 9. Any questions pertaining to specific exhibits should be directed to the Virtual Homecraft chairperson; Lia Johnson 905-432-0528.
- 10. Items will be judged in accordance with the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) Judging Standards book or the Ontario Horticultural Judging Standards book. Digital entries and physical entries will be judged equally.
- 11. Items entered will be judged at the Judge's discretion based on merit and Judges are not obligated to award a 1st prize in any class. All judges decisions are final.
- 12. Entries will not be on physical display this year but entries may be displayed virtually.
- 13. Exhibits will not be returned and will become property of the Brooklin Spring Fair to be used in the future at the discretion of the fair or as otherwise stated in the homecraft book.
- 14. The Society will not be responsible for any loss or postal disruptions in the delivery of the entries.
- 15. All prize money is donated by the Brooklin Spring Fair Agricultural Society unless otherwise stated.
