
Together, we made sure the 110 year old tradition of the Brooklin Spring Fair continues -

2021 Virtual Non-Livestock Competitions

Please be patient as we work through this new process to bring you Brooklin Fair's first ever virtual homecraft!

RULES:

- 1. Entry Forms may be submitted by:
 - a. Mail Entry Forms to: Brooklin Spring Fair Homecraft Entry PO Box 35, Cannington ON L0E1E0
 - b. On-line, Complete Entry Forms at: www.brooklinspringfair.com through assistexpo.
- 2. All Paper (Mailed) Entry Forms must be postmarked no later than Friday May 7th, 2021.
 - a. If/when mailing please do not lick the envelopes but seal them with tape/glue.
 - b. Entries for paper entry forms are to be mailed and postmarked no later than Wed. May 26 and sent to:

- c. Mailed entries MUST include the exhibitor name and category attached to each entry.
- 3. All Online Entry Forms must be received through the online enty platform by midnight Thursday May 27th.
 - a. Entries for online entry forms MUST be submitted at the same time as you submit your entry form. You can add your categories to the "cart" but do not check out until such time as you have uploaded all photos of your entries.
- 4. All entries must be submitted on the printed Entry Form provided in this prize list catalogue or through the online playform on the website. Paper Entry Forms can be photocopied if more space is required. Entry Forms must be dated and signed by the exhibitor when mailing.
- 5. All work must be that of the exhibitor. For online entires, all photos of enrites must be originals taken by the Exhibitor. A maximum of one entry photo per section will be accepted.
- 6. All exhibitors must be amateurs.
- 7. All exhibits must not have been previously shown at the Brooklin Spring Fair and will not be judged as a result.
- 8. No person shall enter more than one article per section.
- 9. Any questions pertaining to specific exhibits should be directed to the Virtual Homecraft chairperson; Lia Johnson 905-432-0528.

- 10. Items will be judged in accordance with the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) Judging Standards book or the Ontario Horticultural Judging Standards book. Digital entries and physical entries will be judged equally.
- 11. Items entered will be judged at the Judge's discretion based on merit and Judges are not obligated to award a 1st prize in any class. All judges decisions are final.
- 12. Entries will not be on physical display this year but entries may be displayed virtually.
- 13. Exhibits will not be returned and will become property of the Brooklin Spring Fair to be used in the future at the discretion of the fair or as otherwise stated in the homecraft book.
- 14. The Society will not be responsible for any loss or postal disruptions in the delivery of the entries.
- 15. All prize money is donated by the Brooklin Spring Fair Agricultural Society unless otherwise stated.

As this is an online competition this year, there have been some changes and additions to the Nail Drive rules. Please read carefully.

Nail Drive competition kits can be purchase from Brooklin Home Hardware during regular business hours at a cost of \$10 for a single competitor or \$15 for a family (up to five competitors). Kits will be available for purchase as of April 26, 2021. Stock is limited so be sure to purchase early to avoid disappointment!

Once you have purchased your kit, film your attempt based on the below rules and upload your video as part of your registration for the competition at brooklinspringfair.com.

RULES:

1. Each competitor may submit and upload one video submission only, or will be disqualified. **Deadline for video submissions is May 30, 2021.**

2. Your video submission must be a live taping of your attempt which is one continuous shot, no edits, and must start with the competitor saying: "My name is ____ competing in the 2021 virtual Nail Drive Competition". If there is an edit between this statement and nail drive attempt, the submission will be disqualified.

3. Every swing that hits the nail, or appears to hit the nails, will count in the running tally for your attempt. Ensure that the view on your video clearly shows the nail and the hammer.

4. Your video submission cannot exceed 4.5 minutes, or it will not be accepted.

5. A panel of independent judges will be assembled by the Brooklin Spring Fair and Brooklin Home Hardware to review each video and complete the "swing count" for each competitor. In the event of a tie prize money will be split amoung the winners at the discretion of the Brooklin Spring Fair. Judges' decisions are final.

Deadline for video submissions is May 30, 2021.

The winners will be announced, and their submitted videos will be featured online on our live feed, Saturday June 5, 2021 at 4PM. Please visit www.BrooklinSpringFair.com for complete Live Feed details.

As this is an online competition this year, there have been some changes and additions to the Spring Sing rules. Please read carefully.

Video, Audio Equipment & Submission Details

1. Each competitor may submit and upload one video submission only, or will be disqualified.

2. Your video submission must be a live vocal performance which is one continuous shot, no edits, and must start with the singer saying: "This submission is for Brooklin Spring Sing 2021". If there is an edit between this statement and the performance, the submission will be disqualified.

3. Contestants' voices and vocal performances cannot be pre-recorded, multi-tracked, overdubbed, time corrected, pitch corrected, or manipulated in any way.

4. Contestants must sing live in front of the camera's built in microphone only. Contestants may not use a hand held style microphone or a separate microphone. Note: This is necessary to help ensure vocals are not pre-recorded and/or edited.

5. Judges will not award or remove marks for the quality of the video or audio recording. Keep it simple please. There are no extra marks for professional style videos and recordings.

6. Your video submission cannot exceed 4.5 minutes, or it will not be accepted.

7. Please upload your video at www.BrooklinSpringFair.com (Spring Sing Competition Submissions) on or before submission deadline posted above.

Song Details

8. Each competitor may sing one song only, which is 4 minutes or less. (As noted above, final video may not exceed 4.5 minutes.)

9. All songs must be expletive free (i.e. radio version).

10. Competitors can sing along with pre-recorded karaoke style music tracks that do not contain any lead or double vocals (back ground vocals on the track are OK). Alternately competitors can sing acapella or sing solo along with a single instrument. The instrument may be pre-recorded, played by the competitor or played live by someone else.

11. A panel of independent judges will be assembled by the Brooklin Spring Fair Spring Sing Committee, to view and judge the performances. Judges' decisions are final.

12. Judging will be based on singing quality, performance and originality.

13. Placing other than Top 3 will not be disclosed and no individual performance notes will be provided.

14. Cash prizes will be provided for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places as follows:
